

AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
TOOELE COUNTY, TOOELE CITY  
AND  
TOOELE COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made and entered into this 30 day of September, 1995, by and between **TOOELE COUNTY** and the **TOOELE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**, (hereinafter jointly referred to as "County"), and **TOOELE CITY**, (hereinafter referred to as "City").

**PURPOSE:** This agreement is for the purpose of defining the parties' roles and responsibilities pertaining to Tooele City Public Works using the Tooele County Emergency Management 800 MHz system.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the County and City agree as follows:


1. The City's Public Works radio system is outdated and inoperable and City needs an operable communications system.
2. County agrees to allow City to use Emergency Management's 800 MHz EOC command frequency for their day-to-day public works needs subject to the following restrictions:
  - a. The EOC command frequency shall not be used by the City Public Works during EOC exercises or during an emergency that requires activation of the EOC and/or community command posts. The date and duration EOC exercises shall be given to the City in writing per occurrence.
  - b. City will use the 800 MHz Public Works frequency during EOC exercises and emergencies.


c. County will provide training to City on the FCC rules and guidelines governing public radio use.

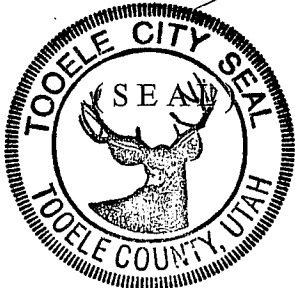
3. In exchange for the City's utilizing the County's 800 MHz system, the City agrees to immediately transfer its current public works highband frequency license to Tooele County.

4. This agreement shall remain in effect unless terminated by any party, with or without cause, by giving sixty (60) days prior written notice of the intent to terminate.



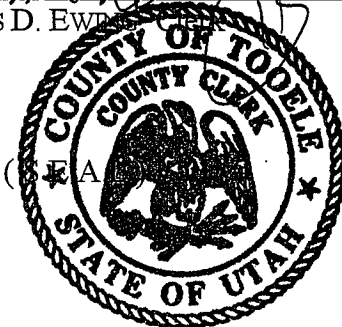


